Postgraduate Master's Programme (Second-level): CLINICAL PERIODONTOLOGY
Educational Objectives
The main educational objective is the development of diagnostic, prognostic and therapeutic skills for the treatment of patients diagnosed with periodontal disease. The Programme is intended for graduates in Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics who wish to deepen their knowledge and acquire clinical skills in the management of periodontal patients. The educational programme will include lectures, clinical hands-on sessions, seminars and activities involving patients, through which participants will acquire the skills required to become professionals capable of managing and coordinating periodontal diagnosis and treatment. Clinical activities involving patients, carried out at the Dentistry Unit of Santa Maria alle Scotte University Hospital in Siena, will enable participants to acquire the technical and procedural skills required for appropriate treatment.
